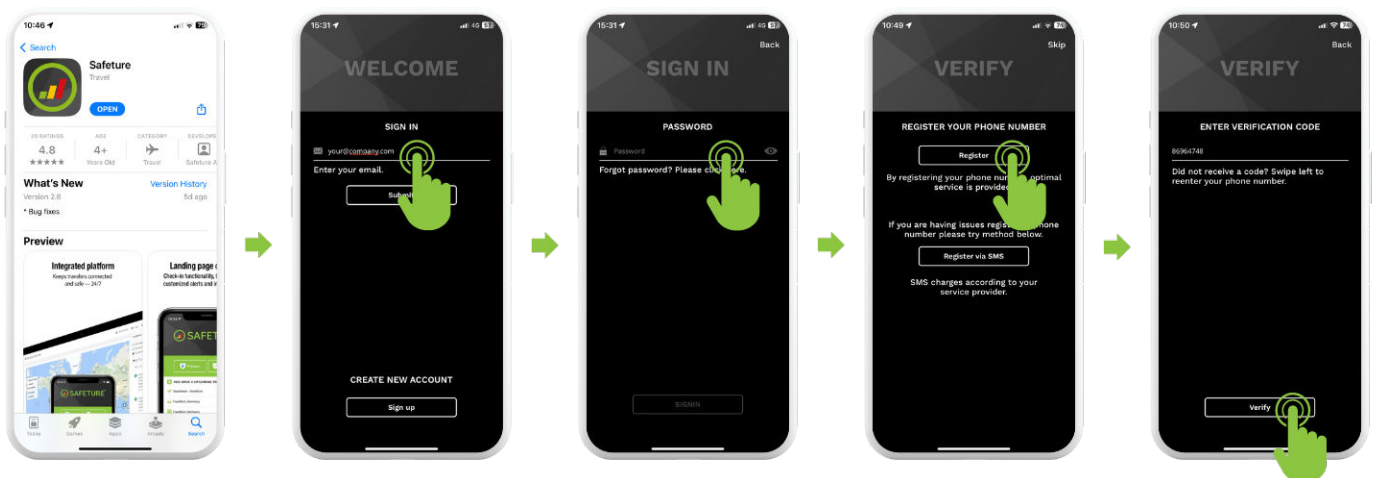
Safeture is your ultimate companion for staying safe during travel and in your daily life.

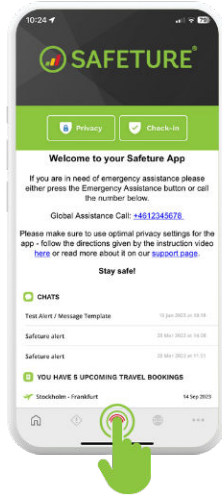

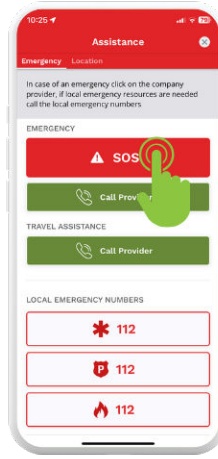

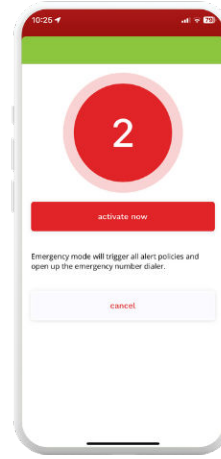
Quick Start Initiate Emergency



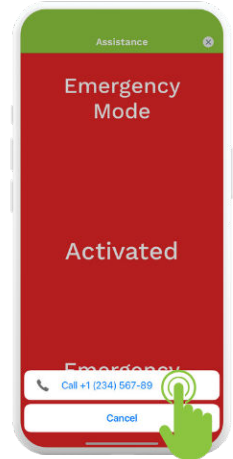
1 From home screen, push the Emergency button



2 Push SOS button

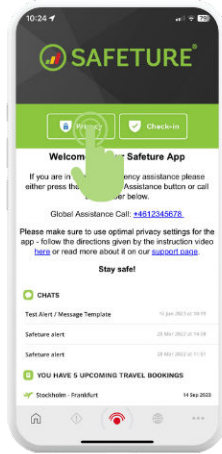


3 Wait 5 seconds or activate now

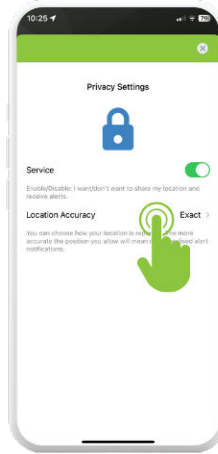


4 Call emergency provider if needed

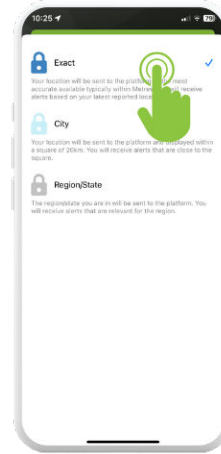
Quick Start Change Privacy



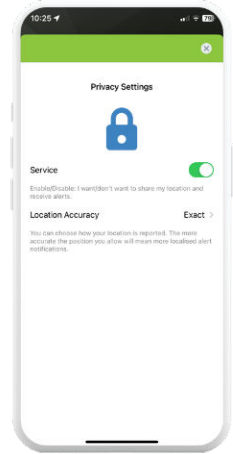
1 From home screen, push Privacy at the top

FAQ

Change Privacy Settings

To change your privacy, go to “Privacy” on the Welcome page in the app. You can set privacy for exact, city, and region/state. Also, make sure to set your phone’s location to “always allow.”

Filter Alerts

You can filter what you see on the map in the app’s alerts tab. You’ll always get relevant push notifications based on your location, regardless of risk.

Battery Usage

Safeture generally uses about 2% of your battery when in the background during a day.

No Internet Connection

While internet is best, the app works with cellular networks. Critical functions like the emergency button, chat, and check-in are available.

View Travel Bookings

Your travel appears in the app when we receive it from your organization’s Travel Management Company. You’ll get alerts 72 hours before your departure.

Missing Travel Booking

If your booking isn’t there, contact your organization’s Safeture administrator for help. You can’t add bookings manually.

App Languages

Safeture supports system languages and offers machine translation for more languages. You can change this in the app’s settings.
